Activity: Transfer to your hotel, meeting and greeting your guide

[Day 2: Drive to Lake Naivasha and enjoy a host of optional activities.](#)

Following breakfast, travel to south through the Great Rift Valley; encounter the magnificent view of the Rift Valley at the foot of the escarpment, moving on to Lake Naivasha. You will arrive in time for lunch at Loldia House. Check in to your charming colonial style accommodation with beautiful views of the dormant volcano, Mount Longonot. Wild animals roam free on the farm and in the evenings, hippos munch quietly by the waterside. At Loldia House you'll experience the life of Kenya's early settlers. Loldia House is an ideal spot to relax, taste the pleasures of Kenyan country life and explore the Great Rift Valley. Activities at Loldia House include visits to local flower farms,

visits to the local school, bird-watching by boat on Lake Naivasha, visits by boat to Crescent Island (excluding entrance fees), and walks with the resident naturalist, horse-riding.

Activity: Transfer to Lake Naivasha and spend the afternoon enjoying optional activities.

Day 3: Drive to Lake Nakuru National Park

After breakfast depart for Lake Nakuru National park .Game drives around Lake Nakuru. This Lake has over 400 other bird species. In addition, you will get a chance to animals including the introduced Rothschild's giraffe, black and White Rhino, Waterbuck, Reed buck, Lion, Buffalo, Leopard, Baboon and many species of plains game. Later return to Loldia for overnight.

Activity: Transfer to Lake Nakuru National park, enjoy afternoon game drive.

Day 4: Fly to Maasai Mara National Reserve

Day four takes you to the Maasai Mara Reserve, where you will enter the domain of the Maasai. Kenya's Maasai are nomadic cattle herders and one of the best-known African ethnic groups, and they strive to preserve their traditions and culture in the face of modernization. The Maasai depend heavily on their cattle for milk, and Maasai women make money by selling beadwork. The Mara Reserve claims to have Kenya's most abundant concentration of wildlife and is regarded by many travelers as a crucial stop on any African safari. The reserve belongs to the Maasai people. Tonight you'll stay at the luxurious Little Governors' Camp, an intimate camp tucked around a large watering hole that teems with both birds and wildlife. The camp is approached by a boat ride across the Mara River, then an escorted walk through the riverine forest. Vehicles are left on the far river bank, and the camp is therefore quiet and undisturbed... This is what comes to mind



when most people think of a safari. Your time here will certainly give you a sampling of all the natural wonders that Kenya has to offer.

Activity: Transfer to Maasai Mara; enjoy an afternoon game drive

Day 5: Morning and afternoon game drives.

Once again you will be able to experience game-drives in the morning and in the afternoon. Both drives will give you great wildlife viewing opportunities. You will see large herds of local grazing animals going by, and also have a good chance of seeing some of the big cats. If you're able to visit between July and October, you may be able to witness the Great Migration, when huge herds of Thomson's gazelles, wildebeests and zebras travel in mass from the Serengeti. It is an unforgettable experience that is not to be missed. No matter when you visit, you will also have a chance to take a "walking safari", or visit a local tribal village if you wish. You will learn about the Maasai way of life and how they have managed to retain their semi-nomadic customs even in today's modern world,



when so much of their world is at risk. After all these adventures, you will be more than ready for a mid-day nap, a dip in the pool or laze on the veranda to escape the heat of the day.

Day 6: Fly to Nairobi and connect with flight to Mombasa.

See for yourself why the beach is internationally renowned as you luxuriate in the warm aquamarine waters or engage in a variety of outdoor activities. Possibilities include professional scuba-diving instruction, dives on East Africa's largest artificial reef, big game fishing, water sports, windsurfing, canoes and fun boats. There are also organized weekend sailing camps for young sailors as well as glass-bottom boat rides, low-tide reef walks with specially trained marine guides and dhow safaris with picnics and sundowners.

Activities include daily family entertainment such as tennis, water polo and volleyball, tug-o'-war competitions, table tennis, pool tables, and video games as well as golf. A range of water sports are also available. Excursions include visits to Wasini island, Shimba hill national reserve, Haller Park (formerly Bamburi Nature Trail), Mamba Crocodile Farm, Fort Jesus and Gedi Ruins. The historic Mombasa Old Town and Harbor are all available for exploring.
